We own and operate over 200 energy sites globally, with 45 onshore wind plants across the UK with over 1,000MW installed capacity, using diverse technologies including onshore and offshore wind, solar, biomass, and energy storage.

In Scotland, we have a strong operational footprint and are proud of the contribution we make to Scotland's climate ambitions. Our dedicated Scottish team works closely with communities across the country, ensuring that our projects are shaped by their views and actively support long-term local sustainability.

Galawhistle Wind Farm Extension

Galawhistle Wind Farm is located approximately 7km east of Muirkirk in East Ayrshire and 5km west of Douglas in South Lanarkshire.

The project currently consists of 22 turbines and our proposals would see the development of five additional turbines with a maximum tip height of up to 200m, capable of generating 36MW.

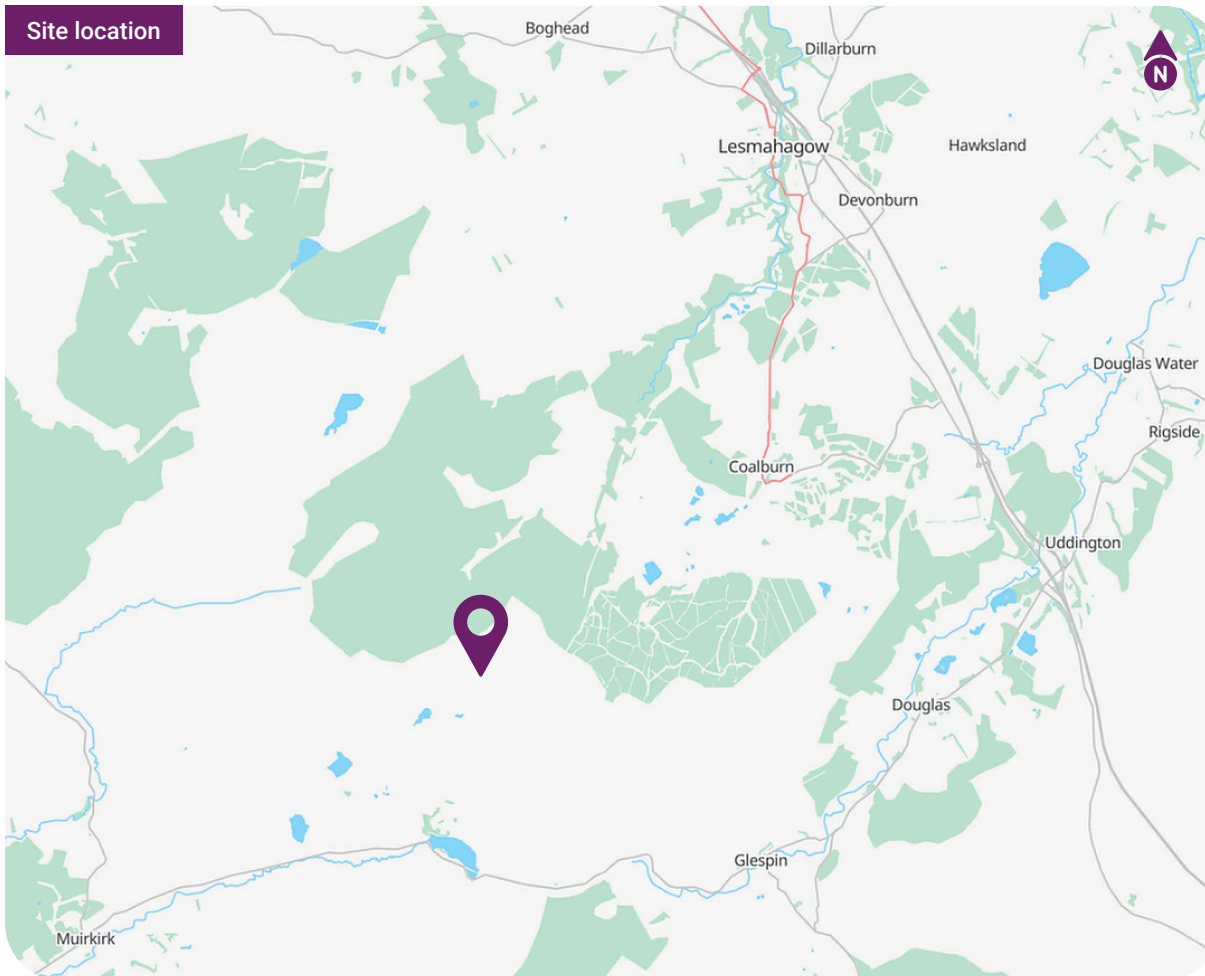

Since becoming operational in 2017, Galawhistle Wind Farm has supported local communities and the regional supply chain.
