Lambrigg Repowering and Extension

Nadara is exploring the potential to repower and extend Lambrigg Wind Farm. It is located approximately 5.7km east of Kendal and is bounded on its eastern edge by the M6 motorway.

Our proposals would see the development of up to seven turbines, with a maximum blade tip height of 200m, capable of generating up to 42MW of renewable energy.

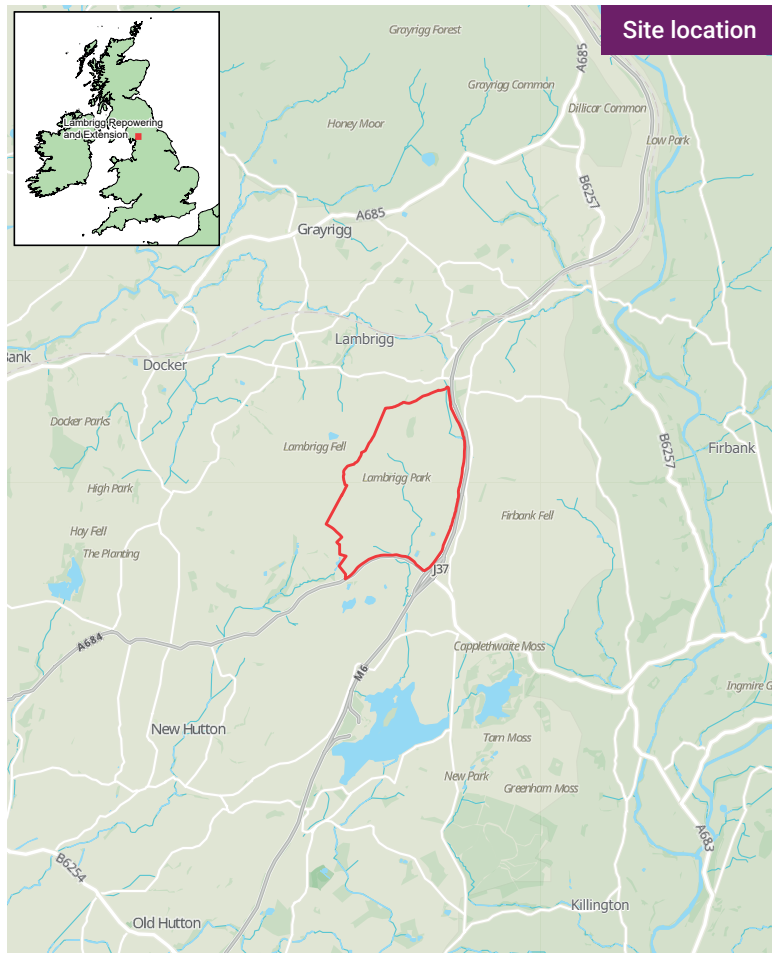

Lambrigg Wind Farm has been operational since 2000. We are now exploring the potential to repower and extend the wind farm to the north of the site.

Since becoming operational in 2000, Lambrigg Wind Farm has supported local communities and the regional supply chain.

If consented, Lambrigg Repowering and Extension, would create a community benefit fund of up to £210,000 each year – totalling over £7 million across the project's anticipated 35-year lifespan.

We want to work with the local community and explore the potential to provide community ownership.
